

## **Three Minute Thesis Competition Rules**

- A single static PowerPoint slide is permitted. No slide transitions, animations or 'movement'
  of any description are allowed. The slide is to be presented from the beginning of the
  oration.
- No additional electronic media (e.g., sound and video files) are permitted.
- No additional props (e.g., costumes, musical instruments, laboratory equipment) are permitted.
- Presentations are limited to 3 minutes maximum and competitors exceeding 3 minutes are disqualified.
- There will be a timer placed in front of you to help you keep track of your presentation time.
- Presentations are to be spoken word (e.g., no poems, raps or songs).
- Presentations are to commence from the stage.
- Presentations are considered to have commenced when a presenter starts their presentation through either movement or speech.
- The decision of the adjudicating panel is final.
